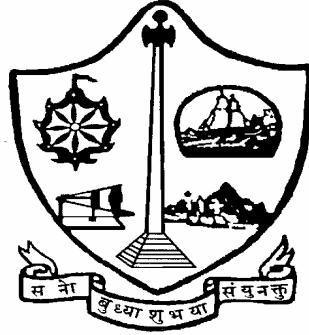

1. INTRODUCTION

Samanta Chandra Sekhar College, Puri, founded in 1944, became a lead college of the State in 1990, and an autonomous Institution in 1999. While the conferment of autonomy acknowledges the role, the college has played in disseminating knowledge, it has at the same time enjoined upon the institution to continue in its efforts to achieve academic excellence in different fields and the NAAC has accredited the institution with B++ grade on recognition of its excellence in academic, cultural, games and sports and other co-curricular activities offered by the institution.

2. REOPENING

The college will reopen after Summer Vacation on 17th June, 2008.

4. EXAMINATION SYSTEM

Only such students who satisfy the requirements of attendance (as laid down by the Government) in all subjects shall be allowed to appear at the Semester Examinations Conducted by the College.

Filling- up of forms for each Semester Examination is mandatory.

The Students of both **Under Graduates and Post Graduates classes shall appear at Two Semester Examinations in an academic year to be conducted by the College**, One towards the end of November / Ist Week December and the other towards the end of April tentatively. The marks secured in both the examinations shall be taken into account for the finalization of the result.

The Students of +3 Degree-Ist Year /2nd Year /3rd year (Arts/ Commerce/Science) Shall have to appear at two Internal Assessments (Written examination) for each theory of all compulsory, Pass, Elective(Major Elective & Minor Elective) and Honours Papers before Semester Examination, the appearance of the students at these examinations is compulsory. Out of the two Internal Assessments, the one in which scoring is higher will be taken into consideration towards the final results. The Internal Assessments carry 20% of marks in each paper and the student shall be examined for the rest 80% of marks in the Semester Examination as per Course Structure.

5. TEACHING FACILITY:

The College Offers Undergraduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) programme in the following streams/facilities.

5(A) UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME:

The College Provides honours teaching facility in the subject with sanctioned strength as given below.

5(A) I.ARTS STREAM(3 Year Degree Course) Sanctioned strength -512.

A student shall offer one honours Subject and two elective subjects (Elective "A" in its Ist Year and Elective –'B' in 2nd year) apart from the compulsory subjects. Honours subjects shall be allotted to the applicants for admission by taking into consideration (a) the option of the applicant in the application form, (b) his/her eligibility and position in the faculty merit list in the concerned subject and (c) the seat strength in the corresponding honours subject. The College offers the following honours subjects, elective subjects and compulsory subjects. No candidate shall be allowed to take Mathematics, if his/she did not obtain Math as an optional subject at +2 level.

(b) Elective Subjects with Seat Strength

However, a student can not offer an elective subject directly related to his/her honours Subject or an Elective subject can not choose another language subject as his / her elective subject. The allotment of an elective subject to an applicant is subject to his/her merit position and availability of seats in the subject concerned.

NOTE : (i)It is important to note that **Honours in Comp. Science is a self –financing course with a course fee of Rs.30,000/-**(non refundable): @Rs. 10,000/- per annum for the three years in addition to normal admission/ readmission fees & Examination fees. However, should a student discontinue his/her studies or withdraw from the course at any stage for reasons whatsoever he/she would still be under obligation to pay the course fee in full, failing which he/she would still not be issued the college Leaving Certificate.

(ii) The selection of Honours for Computer Science would be made on the basis of total marks secured in the last qualifying examination subject to pass in both Physics and Mathematics.

5.B.POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The College offers Post Graduate teaching in (1)Commere-48 Seats, (2)English-32 Seats, (3)Zoology-16 Seats, (4) Oriya-32 Seats and (5) Computer Science(Self Financing Course)-16 Seats.

Note-(i)For M. Sc. Computer Science (Self Financing), a Sum of Rs. 40,000/-(non-refundable)@Rs.20,000/-per annum shall be collected as course fees in addition to normal admission/readmission fees & Examination fees. However, should a student discontinue his/her studies or withdraws from the course at any stage for reasons whatsoever, he /she would still be under obligation to pay the course-fees in full, failing which he/she will not be issued the college leaving certificate.

(ii) The PG Course in Computer Science will continue provided minimum 8(eight) students take admission in the Subject.

5.(C) P.G. Diploma In Early Childhood care, education & Training (Self financing course)=32 seats

A candidate desirous of taking admission to the course shall have to secure 45% marks in aggregate of the Degree Examination in arts or Science only and they have to qualify in an Entrance Test for

admission. The course will be of one year duration and the course fee shall be Rs. 4,500/- in addition to admission charges.

6. ELIGIBILITY

I) For Undergraduate (3 year Degree Admission)

Candidate who has passed the CHSE Examination/ Equivalent Examination with 40% minimum marks in aggregate (Without Fourth Optional) shall be considered for admission.

II) For Post Graduate Admission

Candidates who have passed in the final of Three years Degree examination from any recognized university with 45% of marks (in concerned Honours subject) can apply for admission.

7. AVAILABILITY OF APPLICATION FORM

- i) Application forms alongwith the Information Brochure can be obtained (a) in person from the collection counter of the College between 11AM & 3 P.M on all working days on payment of Rs. 80/- (Rupees Eighty) only. (b) The same can also be obtained by pst by remitting Rs. 130/- in shape of A/C payee Bank Draft drawn in favour of principal S.C.S College Puri payable at any Nationalised Bank at Puri and enclosing a self addressed Envelope(30 cm x 25 cm) which must reach the college by the stipulated date. (c) Moreover Application Form & Information Broucher can also be downloaded from the college Web Site i.e(www.scscollege.nic.in).But in such cases the Candidate has to enclose a Demand Draft/ Banker's Cheque of Rs.80/- in favour of Principal SCS College, Puri along with the Application Format failing which the Forms will be summarily rejected. **Applications received after the stipulated date shall be treated as LATE APPLICATIONS.**
- ii) A candidate desirous of being considered for admission to the first year class of Three years Degree Course in Arts/Commerce/Science shall have to submit separate application for each stream/ group/course.
- iii) The Science candidates desirous of being considered for admission to three different groups in Science Stream, such as CBZ(Chemistry, Botany, Zoology) or PCM(Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics) of PM Comp Sc(Physics, Mathematics & Computer Science Hons.) shall have to submit separate application for each group.

To save students from financial hardship Additional Application forms” (i.e. forms without Brochure) are sold at a concessional rate of Rs. 60/- subject to the condition that all such forms and the Additional forms) are purchased at a time. Candidates shall be provided with separate money receipts for all such forms.

8. HOW TO APPLY

Candidates are required to fill in the forms in their own handwriting and provide all necessary information as required therein. They shall fill in the Main Application Form along with the Index Card. Entries in all columns should be filled in properly with suitable answers and not by dots or dashes or cross marks. “NA” should be written whenever anything is not applicable. Index card-cum-Acknowledgement portion of Application form should be duly filled in. It should be affixed with postage stamp of Rs.6/- by the candidate who submit the application form by post.

- i) An applicant seeking admission into the Degree Class is required to mention clearly the Stream/Group/ Course, he/ she is willing to take. Applicants are required to give three choices in order of preference for Honours in the Application form.
He/She is also required to mention the MIL subject and Compulsory/Pass / Elective Subject chosen by him/her from the group combination in the Application form.
- ii) Candidates desirous of residing in the College Hostel should clearly mark, “HOSTEL” on the top of the front page of the Application form.
- iii) Women(W), Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe(ST), Burma Repatriate(BR), Physically Handicapped(PH), outside State Candidate(OS), Children of Ex-Serviceman(ESM), Children of Serving Defence Personnel(SDP), Candidates claiming weightage for Sports, NCC,NSS etc. Should mark

W/SC?ST/BR/PH/OS/ESM/SDP/Sports/NCC/NSS respectively at the top of the application form and information sheet, If an applicant claims weightage/reservation for more than one category, all the relevant categories must be stated.

iv) The Application form, complete in all respects alongwith necessary documents as given below shall be sent in the envelope (already issued by the College, at the time of purchase of Application form) to the Principal, S.C.S College (Autonomous), Puri by Registered post/Speed post only. The same can be handed over at the receiving counter of the College. **Ordinarily no application form will be received through Courier Service.** The Candidates are required to mention the name of the Stream/ Group/ Course to which he/she Applying for, in the space provided on the envelope containing Application form.

v) **(a) Sale of Application Form:-From 01.06.2008 on all working days from 11.00 am to 3.00pm.**

(b) Last date of Sale and Receipt of Application Form:

For U.G.- Within 15 days from the date of publication of +2 results, CHSE, Orissa or reopening of the College whichever is later.

For P.G.- Within 15 days from the date of publication of +3 results, Utkal University/S.C.S(A) College, Puri or reopening of the College whichever is later.

vi) Documents to be submitted alongwith the application form:

1. Original Money Receipt of Application Form.
2. Self Attested photo copies of Marksheets and Certificates of HSC(10th pass)
3. Self Attested Photo Copy of Marksheets of H.S(+2) examination. In case of compartmental candidates, the attested copies of marksheet of both the examinations shall be submitted.
4. Self Attested Photo copy of Marksheet of Degree (+3) Examination.(For P.G)

N.B.:-Handwritten or non-computerized Marksheets will not be ordinarily considered.

5. Self Attested Photocopy of College Leaving Certificate.

6. Two self addressed envelopes.

7. Self Attested Photo Copies of (for claiming Reservation/Weightage)

a)Caste Certificate in case of SC/ST candidates(issued by local MLA/MP/Tahasildar)

b) Burma Repatriate Certificate from Special Officer, Burma Rehabilitation (for Son/Daughter only of a Burma Repatriate).

c)Physically Handicapped Certificate(issued by CDMO of the District concerned /CMO(of Capital Hospital)/ Professor or Associate Professor of any Medical College in Orissa to the appropriate extent of disability more than 40%.

d) Certificate to the effect of Father /Mother serving in Defence at present.

e)Ex-Serviceman Certificate (issued by Rajya Sainik Board)Zilla sainik Board alongwith- Discharge Certificate.

f)Certificate in respect of Weightage relating to NCC/NSS Sports etc. from the appropriate authority.

g) Permanent Resident Certificate from the Competent Revenue Officer or any other document as specified in Sl.No.9(Note-Vii/0of the Prospectus).

NOTE:-

- i) The applicant is required to write "Submitted by me" on the application form as well as on each of there enclosed documents and put his /her Full Signature with date, without which the application is likely to be rejected.
- ii) No certificate will be entertained after submission of application form.
- iii) Applicant who does not enclose copies of certificate in support of reservation/ Weightage with the application form will not be entitled for reservation/ Weightage.
- iv) Suppression of facts or submission of any incorrect information by the applicant, if detected at the time of admission or there after, will render the selection/ admission invalid and the matter will be reported to the Crime Branch/Vigilance to initiate criminal proceedings.
- v) The Principal has the discretion to condone postal delay by five days only, provided the application has actually been registered by the candidate 3 days prior to the last date of the receipt of application.
- vi) Application incomplete in any respect will be summarily rejected.

- vii) Any document /Certificate/marksheet found to be forged/tampered at any stage shall be liable for cancellation and legal action.

NOTE:-I & ii) A candidate claiming reservation under SC/ST category shall submit certificate from MLA/MP of his (or her locality /Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar.

SC/ST:-12% of the seats available shall be reserved for students belonging to ST and 8% of seats for students belonging to SC.

These seats shall not be interchangeable between ST & SC Students, and any reserved seats remaining vacant in either category may be filled up on the basis of general merit list.

If all the seats reserved for ST/SC fully utilized, additional applicants belonging to ST/SC communities to a maximum total extent of 18% (10% for ST & 8% for SC) of the sanctioned strength shall be admitted. Admission for the additional seats will be allowed strictly in order of merit.

iii) A Candidate claiming reservation under Physically Handicapped category shall submit certificate from the CDMO of the district concerned. CMO(of Capital Hospital)/Professor or Associate Professor of any Medical College of Orissa to the appropriate extent of disability(more than 40%).

iv) & v) A candidate claiming reservation under Service Defence Personnel/Servicemen/Ex-Servicemen category shall submit certificate from Rajya Sainik Board/ Zilla Sainik Board.

vi)Outside State Candidates:-A candidate having domicile outside the State of Orissa, Passing from an institution outside the State of Orissa, “Without Oriya as a subject at +2 /equivalent examination shall be treated as an “out Side State” candidate. Such candidate shall be admitted subject to a maximum 05% (not more than 01% from any particular state) of the total suctioned strength in the faculty.

vii) A candidate whose parents are permanent residents of Orissa and has passed the +2 /equivalent examination from an institution outside Orissa, without Oriya as a subject he/she may be considered to be from within the State of Orissa, provided he/she produces a permanent Resident Certificate from the competent Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar to the effect that his/her parents are permanent residents of Orissa or other document such as Voters Photo Identity Card, Land Records, Pan Card or any other document to prove that his/her parents are permanent residents of Orissa.

10. WEIGHTAGE:

For the purpose of admission, weightage will be given to the following categories of applicants. **NOT MORE than ten percent of seats in each class shall be filled up on the basis of Weightage for various extra curricular activities.** Candidates qualifying on merit shall not be given any Weightage.

- i) NCC cadets holding 'B' certificate may get an additional Weightage of 10% marks over and above the aggregate marks (without extra optional) in the H.S or equivalent examination subject to the condition that this additional Weightage will not be considered for an applicant who has failed at least once in Higher Secondary and has subsequently passed.
- ii) Applicants who have represented the State or the Central School/Sainik School at the All India Level in NCC activities will be given Weightage of an additional five percent (05%) marks over and above the aggregate marks (without extra optional in the H.S or equivalent examination subject to production or respective Certificate from the Director General of NCC/Director of NCC of the sponsoring State represented by the applicant.
- iii) NSS volunteers who have represented the country in NSS at International level will be given admission directly.
- iv) NSS Volunteers who have received National Award will get seven percent(7%) Weightage of marks over and above the aggregate marks (without extra optional at H.S or equivalent examination.
- v) NSS volunteers who have received state N.S.S. Award will get five percent (05%) Weightage of marks over and above the aggregate marks without extra optional)at H.S or equivalent examination.

N.B. NSS Certificates for availing the opportunity of Weightage in marks are to be duly countersigned by the Asst. Programme Advisor, NSS Regional Centre, Bhubaneswar.

- vi) In sports/ Games, those who have represented the country at the International level shall get admission directly.
- vii) In Sports/ Games those who have represented the State at the National Level shall get ten percent(10%) and those who have represented the school at the Inter State School Sports meet shall get five(05%) Weightage of marks over and above the aggregate marks (without extra Optional) at H.S. or equivalent examination provided that the sports/ Secretary, CHSE. The Director of Sports, Orissa will issues separate certificate on the participation of the participates in recognized sports/Games for admission purposes.
- viii) **Women:-** A women applicant desirous of taking a subject for which there is no teaching facility in the local Women's College will be given Weightage of an additional five percent (05%) of marks over and above the aggregate marks (without extra optional)obtained by her in the qualifying examination subject to the condition that, the candidate given such weightage will not ordinarily be allowed to change the subject(s) subsequently.

N.B:a) In order to be eligible for additional Weightage in NCC/Sports/NSS, the applicant concerned should have participated in the respective competitions within two years before the date of application for admission.

b) Weightage relating to NCC/ Sports/NSS/Rovers-Rangers/Women Category etc is not applicable to selection for Honours.

c) The candidate may excel in more than one extra curricular activities. He/She is eligible to get weightage in marks for extra curricular activities in which he /she has excelled subject to the condition that total weightage shall not exceed 10(ten) percent of the marks secured.

Important: Candidate claiming Weightage for the aforesaid achievements shall be admitted subject to a maximum of 10% of sanctioned straight of seats of the faculty. First 90% of the seats will have to be allotted purely on merit basis.

11. Intimation to Candidates Selected for Admission.

Intimation for admission shall be sent by Registered Post. The intimation letter shall indicate the date of admission and the date by which the candidate has to send the documents in Original alongwith necessary fees(in shape of Bank Draft) for admission to the Principal.

12. Honours Selection

The Admission shall be made alongwith Honours subjects. If a Candidate is not selected for the Honours subjects for which he/she has given preference in the Application Form he/she will be allotted any other Honours subject available in the stream, if eligible.

The merit list for Honours of various subjects in +3 Degree Arts/ Science/Commerce shall be prepared by taking the aggregate mark (at least 40% of marks without Extra Optional) and marks secured in the concerned subject as outlined in the adjacent page.
